WHY MEDIATE?

- 1. Mediation saves time and money.
- 2. Mediation is confidential.
- 3. Mediation is fair and neutral.
- 4. Mediation allows the parties to craft their own mutually satisfactory resolution to the problem.
- 5. Mediation fosters cooperation and improves communication.
- 6. Mediation helps parties clarify the issues.
- 7. Mediation can resolve all issues important to the parties, not just what is alleged in the complaint.
- 8. Mediation avoids the uncertainty of a judicial outcome.
- 9. Mediation is highly satisfactory for parties regardless of whether the case is settled.
- 10. Parties have nothing to lose by trying mediation.
